If you missed this in the news, production of the ICE Macan will end later this summer. The exact date depends on part supplies. The gas powered Internal Combustion Engine Macan is projected to return in a new form in 2028.

Also in the news, Porsche Patents were filed for a new Air cooled motor. Apparently, the design revives technology used in the race cars and the 959, where water cooled heads were mated to air cooled engine blocks and cylinders. The water cooling on the heads provided better control of the exhaust temperatures in the heads, while the air cooling of the rest of the engine reduces the weight of the car.

For some fun, check out Runge Cars new Hetzer air cooled, 5.3L, flat 8 motor for the 964. I wonder if it could be fit in a 72 911? Mods?

I put a short write up about my latest project in this edition. I finally found a radio to replace the original unit in my 981 Cayman. I wanted to have Carplay and Navigation in the Cayman for longer drives. The unit I found was recommended on the Cayman forums and was plug compatible with the original Porsche radio. The new radio looks very much like the original Porsche radio but has built-in navigation, wireless Carplay and Android Auto. I added a backup camera at the same time. Total install took a full day with the camera taking much of the time.

Vicki and I will be heading to Lake Placid for Porsche Parade. We are leaving a week early to stop in Cleveland for the Stoddard Car Show and Swap Meet and then take our time driving out past the finger lakes area before arriving at the event. I hope we are sending the current warm sunny Wisconsin weather east for the trip.

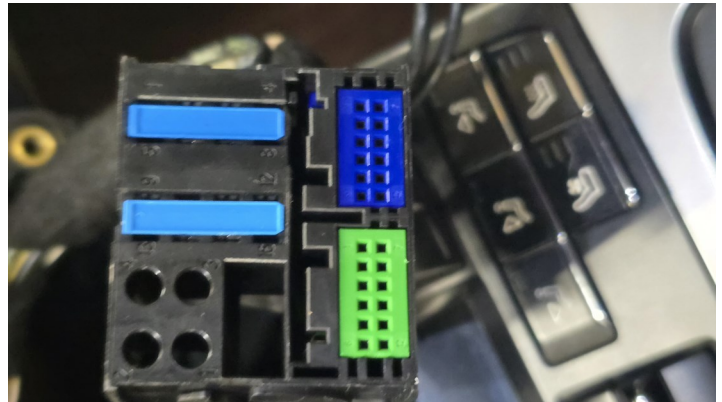

The photos below document the installation of a new radio system in my 981 Cayman. This radio replaced the stock CDR radio with one that supports Navigation, Wireless Carplay and Android Auto, front and back cameras and CANBUS integration. I found this radio in the Cayman forum from other owners who had replaced their radios with it. Installation was simple as the connectors from the Porsche radio connected directly to this radio without needing any adapters. I chose to add the backup camera at the same time. The same radio will work for 718s, 981s and 997s.

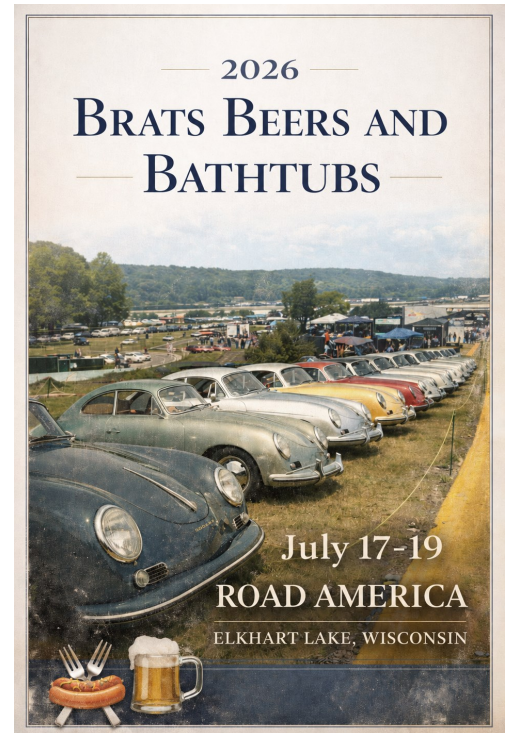

Each attendee bringing an eligible vintage Porsche into the paddock is also responsible for purchasing a \$25.00 WI 356 Club Paddock Pass. This laminated pass is good for the entire event and must be clearly displayed on your dashboard in order to enter and park in the paddock.

Please purchase both your Road America admission ticket and your WI 356 Club laminated paddock pass at the Main Gate.

### Parking Location

Once you enter the paddock, **Turn 5 will be on your right**. You will see the tent and our roped-off parking area.
