Who knows? Maybe Gordon will even benefit from a little extra traffic from FVR members once and a while.

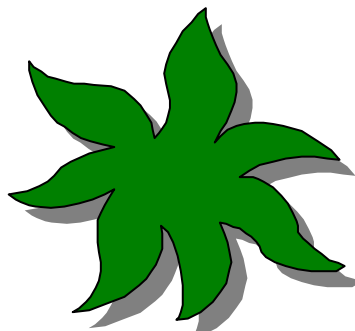
