

Is your data correct?

What you see is what I see and use for the listing of anniversaries.

Members, the listing on the previous page showing members, their membership anniversary date and the vehicle they own, is extracted directly from the national PCA database.

The region doesn't maintain membership data. We pull data from the national database to populate the monthly membership anniversary listing in Whaletales and use the national emailer to send out notices to members.

If the data about your car is wrong, please log in to pca.org and update your membership record. If you are not receiving our emails, log in and correct the record.

In recent months I've been advised by several members that their data was wrong as displayed. Subsequently, they logged on to pca.org (a log-in and password is required —PCA can help you with this) and corrected

their membership record.

In this exchange of emails with members, I also learned that PCA's database only shows one vehicle in the data that is displayed. While there are places in your membership record to add more vehicles, when I pull the data, I only get one vehicle.

I've alerted the national membership chair but haven't gotten a response yet as to why I can only see one vehicle per member.

If you want me to display the year and model of all of the Porsches you own, for now you'll have to alert me so I can do that when it's time for your anniversary to be displayed.

Hopefully, national membership folks can remedy this so that all Porsches owned by members that are captured in their membership record can be included in the Excel file that I download.



Chicago Region Memorial Day weekend Drivers' Education at Road America

The Road America Drivers' Education "RADE" event is



a driver school put on each spring by the Chicago Region Porsche Club with an emphasis on safety. Held in Elkhart

Lake, WI at Road America, one of the premier racetracks in the world. This program has been developed over many years to teach you the skills you need to drive your Porsche at its limits in a safe and secure environment.

This event is held over Memorial Day weekend and is open to all Porsche sports cars that can pass technical inspection (Cayennes or Macans are not allowed), and to all drivers age 18 and older with an emphasis on the novice driver. Starting Thursday night, May 25, with a novice driver meeting, and ending Sunday, May 28, RADE leaves Memorial Day open to celebrate with friends and family.

Pre-registration is required for this event, as on-site registrations will not be accepted. Novice drivers, who have never been on a road course, are strongly encouraged to attend the Autocross Precision Car Control Clinic, as well as, Novice Drivers School at Blackhawk Farms Raceway.

Registration for this event, and all PCA Chicago events, will be on-line only.

and received by May 15, 2017 including a late \$25 processing fee. No refunds after May 15, 2017.

Final event confirmation and information materials including the rules of Road America will be e-mailed to participants from the registrar approximately one week prior to the event.

Event registration and tech will open at Siebkens on Thursday afternoon May 25 from 4 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. They will reopen Friday morning at Road America... time to be announced.

Safety Requirements for All Participants

Safety is the Chicago Region's greatest priority and an active requirement for all participants. Reference the Chicago Region Tech 2017 Sheet for additional information. Brief highlights include:

- Snell Approved SA2010 or newer helmet is required (Motorcycle M helmets are NOT acceptable)
- Mandatory clothing includes long sleeve cotton shirt, long pants and socks, and closed toed shoes. All articles of clothing to be made of non-synthetic materials.
- On Saturday and Sunday group 2, 3 and 4 vehicles may run with stock seats and belts. Group 1 vehicles will require a 5 or 6-point harness with proper race seat and must be equipped with a roll bar or roll cage.
- 993s and earlier cabriolets must have a race-approved roll bar or cage, bolted or welded to the vehicle to participate in drivers' ED events.

Information for Novice Drivers and Registered Instructors

Novice drivers and registered instructors will begin their weekend by attending a mandatory Novice Orientation meeting on Thursday evening, May 25, at 8 p.m. sharp at Siebkens Resort located in Elkhart Lake.

Friday, May 26, at the Track will include novice classroom instruction, and on track time with an assigned PCA Instructor.

Novice drivers will run in their own group on Friday and then Group 4 on Saturday and Sunday.

YOU! Are responsible for meeting all personal and vehicle safety and technical requirements

Mandatory drivers meetings each morning at 7:30 a.m.

No camping is available at Road America. A room block under "PCA Chicago" has been set up at the Osthoff Resort. 800-876-3399.

PCA Chicago Region Tech Inspection sheet is required for this event – Bring it filled out with you to tech.

Saturday and Sunday format is four run groups, with Run Group 1 as the most experienced, and Group 4 with new Drivers' ED participants

You can obtain a permanent car number from Ed Leed at leedlast@sbcglobal.net or the event registrar will assign a temporary car number for this event. You are responsible for bringing to the event the car numbers of contrasting color and they must be a minimum of 8'' tall on the hood and both sides of the vehicle with $1\frac{1}{2}$ " to 2'' stroke. Car numbers cannot be displayed on the windows. Any magnetic numbers must be securely taped in place.

Maximum Road America noise restriction level is 103 decibels.

• ELECTRICITY will only available in the pit lane and upper paddock – fees payable to Road America

Road America track gates will open at approximately 6 p.m. on Thursday and then again 6 a.m., Friday

May 26, Saturday May 27 and Sunday May 28. Gates will close at 8:30 p.m. Thursday through Saturday.

All vehicles including trailers and transporters must exit facility by 6 p.m. on Sunday.

Returning this year is low speed track touring, time permitting, on Saturday and Sunday. This is your chance to take the family out and show them the beauty of Road America! We will ask for a minimum of \$10 donation for this privilege, with all proceeds going to charity.



Directions from Appleton: Take 41 North to Hwy J exit in Kaukauna. Turn right on Hwy J and follow toward Kaukauna. Turn left at first 4-way stop. Turn right at stop sign and go across railroad tracks. At stop sign, turn left onto Hwy 96 toward Wrightstown. Stay on Hwy 96 thru Wrightstown until you come to the Shell gas station on the right. Turn right at Shell gas station and cross bridge over the Fox River. Take first left after bridge onto Hwy ZZ. The Fox River will be on your left. Go approximately 5 miles on Hwy ZZ looking for Wrightstown Road. Turn right on Wrightstown Road. Go 2 miles on Wrightstown Road to River Oaks Drive. Turn left on River Oaks Drive. Look for Southern-style house with big front porch (4th on right-#5571).

Directions from Green Bay: Take Riverside Drive/ Hwy 57 South thru De Pere. Road splits just past Shell station — be sure to stay to the right on Hwy 57. 
