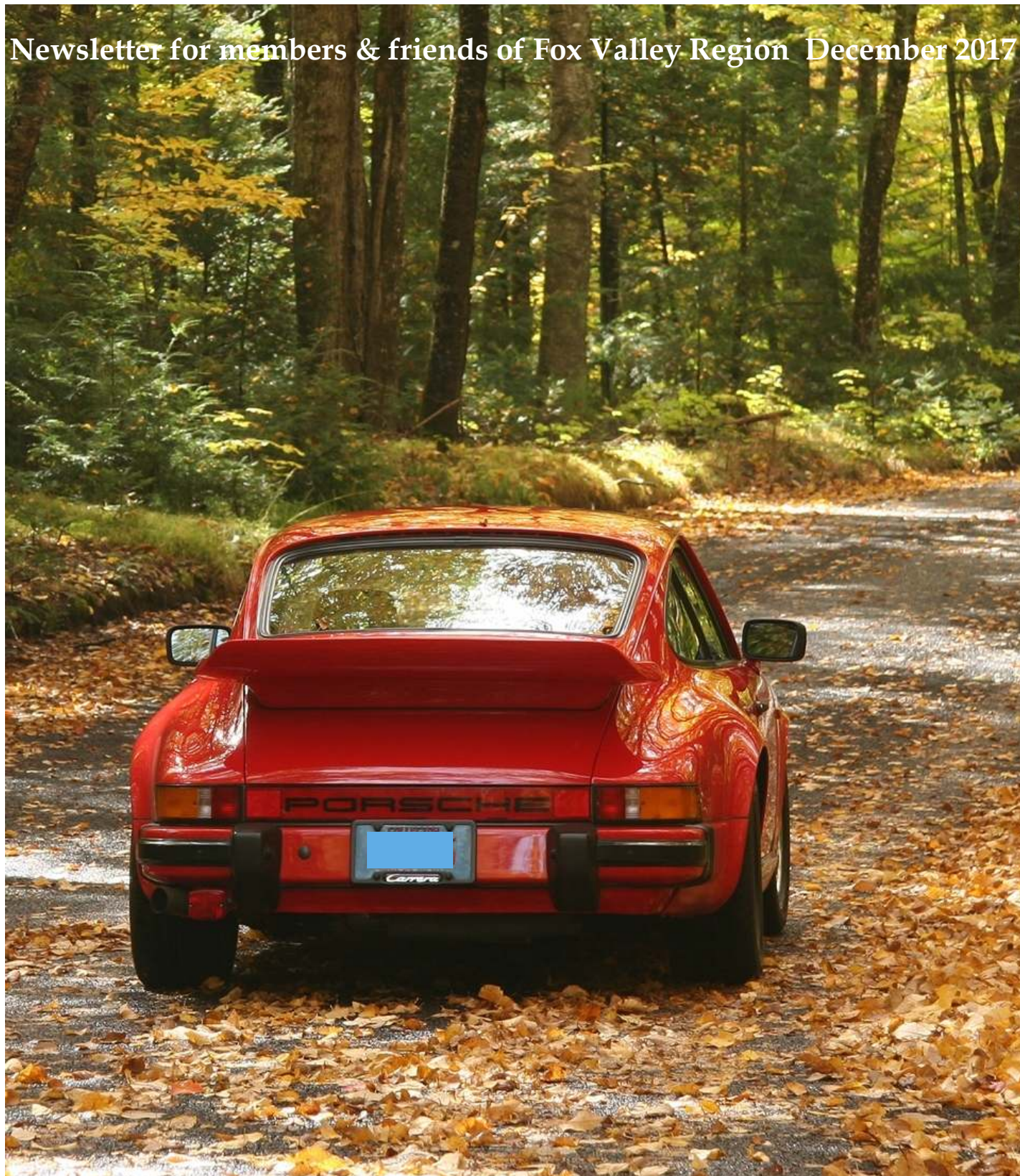

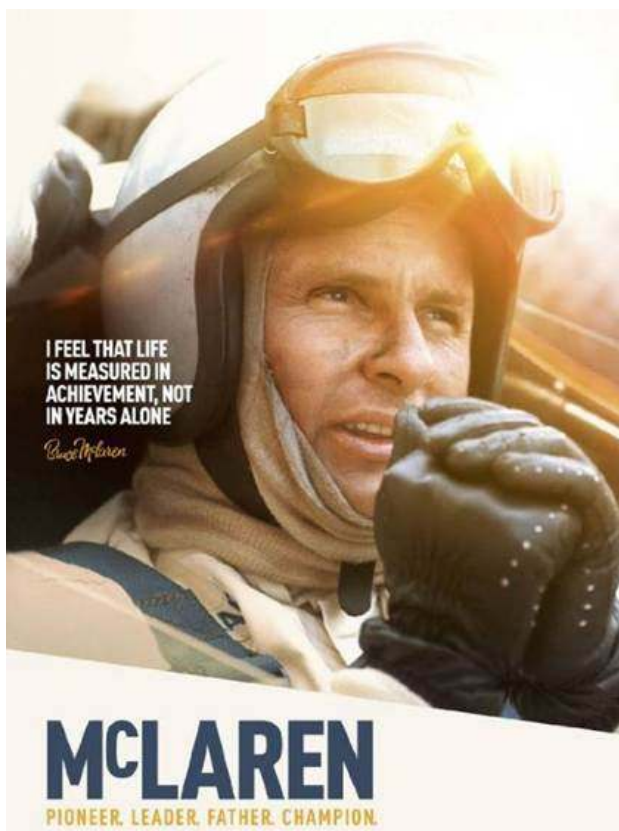

## Service for your Porsche and other imports

Do you live in the northern area of Wisconsin or the Upper Peninsula? Justin Engineering in Arbor Vitae can keep your Porsche, BMW, Audi or other import or domestic vehicle in top running condition.

Steve Justin started the business in 1999, with 22 years of experience as a service technician on his resume. He started working in the automotive industry in 1977 at a VW dealer. Subsequently, he worked as a dealer technician for Porsche, Audi, BMW, Saab, Maserati and other models.

"I cut my teeth working on air-cooled 911s and doing engine overhauls," he said.

"My dad was self-employed, and he wanted me to be in business for myself," Steve said. His dad purchased the land where Justin Engineering is located, on Justin St.,



just off Highway 51 and Airport Road in Arbor Vitae.

A native of Los Angeles, Steve became familiar with the Northwoods of Wisconsin when Steve's parents built a home on Trout Lake in the 1960s.

Justin Engineering has been serving customers for 19 years. The Justin team includes three full-time technicians and two office staff.

The technicians are ASE certified and the shop is designated as a Bosch certified service center.

Services offered include:

- Mechanical service and repair (no bodywork)
- Factory-recommended maintenance
- Electrical and brakes
- Heating and A/C, batteries
- Tire sales, mounting, and advice – will mount and balance your tire purchases shipped to the shop
- Pre-purchase inspections (usually with no charge to the customer)

"We excel at diagnosing electric and drivability problems," Steve said. "Our mechanics stay up to date through training provided by Bosch. With regular training and the use of electronic scanning tools we can ensure our customers receive the best, qualified service."

Steve relayed one example of a typical achievement of his team. A customer with a 911 brought it in because it was making an odd and not normal clunk. "We were able to diagnose this as a suspension problem. We held the car

with the customer's agreement so we could diagnose it properly, and not just throw parts at it and hope that it was fixed. We got it done right the first time," Steve said.

The shop has also performed the intermediate shaft bearing (IMS) replacement, a known issue with Porsches (996 and 997 911s and Boxsters) built from January 2005 to the end of the 997 production.

## Event USA

"Thirty years ago we found that there were many people we knew who shared that interest and after learning how to achieve our goals of getting great tickets and surrounding the event with other experiences and amenities, we decided to make a business out of that.

"Twenty-eight years later, it's still our family-owned and run business and we have served millions of fans.

"We specialize in Green Bay Packer game tickets and packages with and without hotels for games both in Green Bay and on the road, group entertaining experiences at Packers games, and related activities. However, we also provide tickets and packages for many other sports, concerts and theater events, both in Wisconsin and around the world.

"It is our belief, for example, that we have brought more fans to a single Super Bowl than any other company ever has. We can provide superb tickets for virtually any significant sporting, concert or theater event anywhere in the world.

"We have a diversified customer base, ranging from grass-roots fans of sports teams, like the Packers, other teams, and of musical artists, to high-end customers who will fly all over the world to attend big spectator events. And we work with many groups, including fan clubs, businesses and corporations who are rewarding employees or entertaining customers at Packers games and other events.

"There are many places that you can purchase spectator event tickets, with lots of big national companies that have become involved in that business in the last 10 years or so. With those, you are essentially dealing with computers, not a human being, and often paying large markups to acquire tickets.

"None of those can provide you with other experiences

surrounding attending the event itself, such as transportation, lodging, receptions, parties, dining advice, meeting players and performers, etc. We have a staff of experts who can answer all questions and customize complete packages that go along with attending the event of your choice, and provide tickets often at dramatically lower prices than the big national ticket platforms now do.

"We have a staff of approximately 19 individuals who have combined experience of well over 200 years in serving our customers.

"We have many repeat customers who travel from all around the world to attend events with packages that we have set up for them, most particularly Green Bay Packers fans. There are countless stories of personalized services we have rendered to make their visit special. For example, we have a lady from Australia who travels to Green Bay every year to attend a Packers game. She travels by herself and we make sure that when she gets here we get her involved with lots of our activities, meeting our other customers from all around the world, dining with her and meeting Packers players. I believe she enjoys all the things surrounding the game as much or more than attending the game itself.

"Another recent example would be a mother

from South America who wrote to tell us how wonderful it was for her and her son to finally attend a Packers game with us in Green Bay. Her son had saved for three years to pay for his share of the travel and game tickets and other activities that they attended.

"Knowing that he was coming, we made certain that we got them into our player reception, which occurs the night before each home game, without any charge and that he personally got plenty of time to speak with the players," Dennis concluded.

Dennis and his wife Susan and have owned many Porsches over the years, "starting when I was 19 years old and had a couple of 914s," Dennis said. "It evolved from there to the point where we now have quite a variety in our collection. We have a 1956 Pre-A speedster, a 1958 356 coupe, a 1979 930 turbo, a 1998 Boxster (one of the first ever built) that we've owned from new and a 2010 GT3 RS."

### Auto Clinic

"It was always a dream of mine to own and run my own shop, was never able to afford or risk going into business with family responsibilities," said Gordon Skog, long-time member of the region.

"But the opportunity came when my kids were in college or last year of High school and I figured that I could take the risk. One of the biggest things that held me back was the fear of failure, but once I made that first move to purchase this business, there was no turning back," he said. He bought the Auto Clinic business in 1995; the Auto Clinic has been in this location (County Road II in Neenah) since the prior owner started in 1989.

"At the peak of the business I had five technicians and two office staff. I have through the years gradually downsized to two technicians and one office staff. I like and prefer the two and one. Life is much easier," Gordon said.

"I have numerous certifications, too many to list, but the ones I am most proud of are the ASE Certifications, Master Auto Technician and the Advanced Technician. They took a lot of time and were the hardest to obtain. I attended a 2-year Technical College and many years of night schooling while work-



ing full time and supporting my family.

Auto Clinic offers a full range of all mechanical repair on all cars and light trucks. "I prefer to work on Porsches and have many years of experience on them. One of the things that sets Auto Clinic apart from other repair shops is we do all mechanical repair from rebuilding of engines and transmissions to simple oil changes. Most shops shy away from the more labor-intensive repairs," he said.

The shop is open 8 to 5, Monday thru Friday. "But you can ask anyone -- I work nights and weekends too," Gordon said.

Auto Clinic serves as a drop-ship point too. "Customers or members can have anything drop shipped to Auto Clinic. Tires from Tire Rack or engines or anything that we can assist, even if it's just for pick up and not creating any work for the shop," Gordon said.

Demonstrating his expertise, Gordon noted he "just finished one of the more challenging repairs on a 1991 Porsche 911.

"It had bad drivability issues that several other shops were not able to diagnose and repair. The car

finally ended up at Auto Clinic. We had the car for some time trying to figure out all that was wrong. We found some of the repairs were done incorrectly, so we had to figure that out and correct; we also found that at some time there was an engine fire that had burned a good section of the engine main wire harness. Cost to replace the harness was astronomical, so I ended up rewiring and repairing the bad sections. Once we got all the issues resolved and everything put back together and got it up and running and running right, it really was a good feeling of success and a job well done and that makes the struggles and stress worthwhile, a feeling of earned accomplishment."

Gordon drives three Porsches -- a 1977 Porsche 930 Turbo, 1963 Porsche 356B and 1985 1/2 Porsche 944. "All have stories, but the highlights are: the 930 is my first Porsche, is a thrill to drive and I feel the best looking of the three. The 356 I got and restored with my son Joshua, an eleven-year project, fun to drive, light and nimble and comfortable. The 944 I got to be my daily driver so to speak because the other two have gone up so much in value. I spent a bit of time with my son in law to get this one up to par for trips and reliability; it is a comfortable car, a little underpowered, wishing it had a turbo, but a good road car.

"I look back through the years and recall all the opportunities that Auto Clinic has afforded me and feel blessed. From the quality time and involvement with all my family members, the customers that come through our doors throughout all the years that have become friends of mine, to the membership with the Fox Valley Porsche Club and all the friends I made within the club. Yes I am very fortunate and lucky, it makes all the long hours, hard work and stress all worth it. I would do it again in a heartbeat," Gordon concluded.

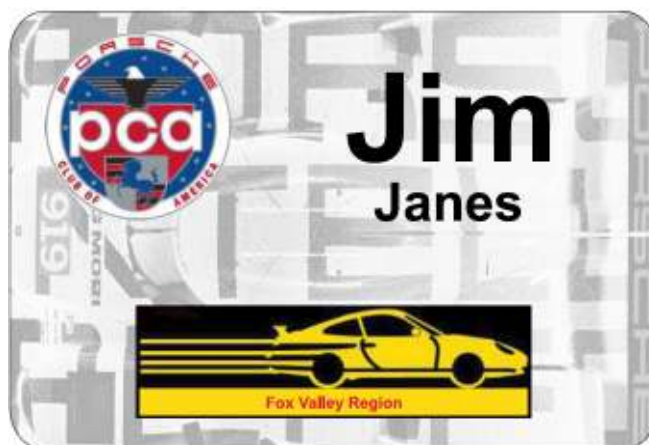

**Porsche History – Did you know?**

In 1977, the launch of the Porsche 928 came during a time of economic crisis with the fallout from the oil embargo earlier that decade. The company was still young, and its strength was building sports and racing cars. Under new leadership, coupled with a new marketing department, Porsche wanted to produce a Gran Turismo supercar. Summoning young engineers from the new Weissach R&D center, Porsche chose a clean-sheet design with a fresh approach, and it carved out a timeless design in the Porsche 928.

The public's first look was at the 1977 Geneva Auto Salon, where it was very well received. There wasn't anything like it at the show. The following year, the 928 was awarded European Car of the Year.



Porsche couldn't have asked for a better reception. The next two years of production saw the largest annual sales in the marque's 18-year lifespan. More than 60,000 were produced worldwide between 1978-1995.
