

Please review our calendar of events in the newsletter but also check out the website and Facebook for activities that may come up between the published newsletters.





We were sports car fans and upgraded from a Fiat 124 sport spider which had gotten run into by a large station wagon. The Fiat was British Racing Green in color. Thus, the interest in the bright color of the Porsche. We still love the car and the color."



Jim Rossol, Baileys Harbor, Wis., notes he has "owned four Porsches starting with a '93 914 2.0 when I was a young pup. A brand new '88 944 Turbo came in to my life when my wife declared she had to have it (lucky me). Much later an '02 911 C2 Cab became mine after a Bergstrom/Porsche driving event at the Technical College.

Robert Hawley, Baileys Harbor, Wis., writes: "The old proverb be careful what you wish for, it might just come true, probably applies in our situation. When I first started dating my wife 10 years ago she was leasing a Ford Explorer. Cars were for A to B, washing was for clothes and maintenance was to be shunned and postponed until the tow truck arrived.

"This winter we flew to Santa Barbara for a few months. We ended up attending no less than eight various Porsche events in our black Kia rental car. Eventually we tired of hauling out our phones to show photos of our cars, and began our quest. Truly it was my wife Jen who started the hunt. She had missed a 2008 Orange limited edition Cayman S by 5 hours! I didn't even know such a thing existed as there were only 100 in North America.

"After a month of searching we found a first year 2006 Speed Yellow Cayman S, with only 33k miles. Though not Porsche certified, the results of the dealer pre-purchase inspection indicated a mint example. After one week it was bought and paid for sight unseen awaiting our pickup in Denver.

"The following Saturday we were attending a very low-key congenial Porsche concours event. Lo and behold a limited edition orange Cayman S showed up. What are the chances? Even more so, it had a for sale sign in the window with a price. We both screamed 'oh no.'

"Jen was hell bent on making it hers. I thought she was joking. Then she started using the same arguments on me that I had spun to her during past Porsche negotiations. Oh my what did I create here?

"Calmly I had her sit in the Kia while we discussed the pros and cons of coming home with two Caymans this winter. Eventually she came to her senses, and passed on the once in a lifetime bottom of the depreciation curve deal.

"So now we happily store, maintain and drive our eight babies. They are all named, naturally, and our latest became Limone, Jen's travel name she picked up in Thailand. I consider myself lucky in more ways than I count; Jen sharing my passion is at the top of that list,"

Rare Ferrari shares garage space with member's Porsches

Whether German or Italian, Dennis and Susan Garriety of Green Bay have an affinity for sportscars, especially rare ones. In addition to their Porsches, they own a 1952 Ferrari 342

America Cabriolet by Vignale # 0232 AL that has competed in concours d'elegance competitions around the world. Dennis tells the story of this Ferrari:

This car is a one-of-a-kind Ferrari. Only six 342 Americas were created. Three of those were cabriolets and three were coupes. Only one of these was bodied by Alfredo Vignale, the first one built, 0232 AL. The other five were bodied by PF. Hence, 0232L is a unique coach built Ferrari.

Ultra-high performance

The 342 America series was the beginning of Ferrari's new strategy to build ultra-high-performance very limited-production luxurious road-going GT cars for its best clientele. This line of custom hand-built bespoke Ferraris began with 0232 AL and continued through the 500 Superfast in 1966.

0232 AL was equipped with a competition-based, Lampredi engine, ultra-high-performance for its era for a road-going vehicle. The 342 America series received even-numbered chassis, reserved only for competition cars by Ferrari. Hence, this indicates that Enzo Ferrari regarded the 342 as a competition car which had been configured and modified for road-going use for sale to its most prestigious and wealthy customers.

We acquired this vehicle in 2017. At that time, we had it immediately inspected by the Ferrari Classiche department by flying a representative from Italy to Wisconsin, before any restoration commenced. We did so to receive their guidance in bringing the car back to its complete original specifications, including color. That initial inspection pronounced that the car was remarkably correct and original with regard to its mechanical components and all sheet-metal and accessories. However, it had been improperly restored previously to an incorrect two-tone color com-

bination with a few other customizations applied. All of that was corrected. Careful forensic examination of the vehicle revealed traces of the original paint in a color of cobalto bleu metallic, as provided by the Lechler paint

company to Vignale in 1952. The samples were matched with original rare paint charts obtained from Switzerland.

And to accomplish installation of the precise grade, gauge and grain signature of the interior leather that would've been used in 1952, samples of original leather from a vehicle manufactured by Vignale in the same timeframe were

obtained and meticulously matched so as to create an interior that would've been precisely as Vignale he would've installed.

Over 300 Ferrari restoration experts and historians were contacted to explore the car's history and to get further input regarding correct restoration approach and technique.

All of this resulted in further examination of the vehicle by the Ferrari Classiche department upon its completion in 2019 and the coveted Ferrari Certificate of Authenticity (the "Classiche Red Book") was issued in the spring of 2019.

Pebble Beach credentials

The car has been displayed at the Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance and participated in the Pebble Beach Tour d'Elégance in 2018 and at the Villa d'Este Concorso d'Elégance in Italy in May 2019.

This May it was one of the cars in the Concorso Villa d'Este that attempted the inaugural Villa d'Este Prelude Tour. In the 90-year history of that event, no tour had been conducted until now. Of the 50 accepted to the Concorso in 2019 from around the world, only 18 attempted the difficult 130 km course over steeply graded serpentine narrow roads, with multiple switchbacks, throughout the mountains surrounding the lake region.

Of those 18 vehicles, only approximately 13 were able to complete the course without issue. 0232 AL performed flawlessly throughout that breathtaking scenic tour.

Almost perfect score

The car received a Best in Class “Platino” award at the FCA Internationals in September 2018 (receiving an almost perfect 100 point score), as well as the Coppa Bella Macchina, which is awarded to cars that can flawlessly demonstrate that they function perfectly in every way, including on a rigorous road test.

It is scheduled to participate in the Suisse National Concours in Geneva, and then the Chantilly Concours near Paris in June. From there it will travel to the Museo Ferrari Modena, at the request of Ferrari so it can be placed in the special exhibit of historic Ferraris. After two months there, the car will travel to England in early September for the Salon Prive Concours d’Elégance near London at Blenheim Palace.

These comments have been written about the car by Ferrari historians:

The first of just six 342 Americas built. One of only three 342 America Cabriolets built, the only one by Carrozzeria Vignale and thus a true and unique one-off. — Marcel Massini

The car embodies the historic role of being the archetype of all luxury Ferraris. And what’s more, it is a genuine one-off special. This is the only example of 342 Americas bearing the haute couture of Vignale. That makes it crystal clear who created the design; the other half of the congenial coachwork duo, namely Alfredo Vignale’s friend Giovanni Michelotti.




Porsche reports May U.S. retail sales

First five months of 2019 up 2.1 percent to more than 25,000 sales year-to-date

June 3, 2019 — Porsche Cars North America, Inc. (PCNA), importer and distributor of the Porsche 911, 718 Boxster and Cayman, Panamera, Cayenne, and Macan model lines, announced record May retail sales of 5,010 vehicles. Overall sales for the first five months are up 2.1 percent from a year ago to 25,052 vehicles.




