# An uplifting experience

If you've ever pondering adding a lift to your garage for storage or maintenance work, hopefully this helps with some questions.


After a lot of research I purchased a Titan SDPL-8000XLT lift from Brians Reparables in Abrams, Wis. Specifications can be found here: <a href="http://www.briansrepairables.com/#!/listing/Titan/53a85ade179e28d65a154d6c">http://www.briansrepairables.com/#!/listing/Titan/53a85ade179e28d65a154d6c</a>

This is a 120V hydraulic lift, plugs into a standard household power outlet. My garage ceiling is 125" tall; plenty of room to stack two 928s, or a 928 above my wife's Beetle.

With the help of fellow FV-PCA members Alan Cayer and Jim Haen, installation was very straight forward. Unpacking and installation is a one day project. Hindsight I would recommend having four people minimum to help lift the runways into position. Using an engine cherry picker and a couple furniture dollies, we got creative and accomplished the job with just three of us.

If you have any questions about purchasing your own lift, please feel free to contact me: erik27@gmail.com. I am not affiliated with Brians Reparables. I was introduced to his operation from another local car club whose members have purchased a number of lifts from him.

To gain more ceiling clearance, I modified my garage door rails to raise the door higher, closer to the ceiling and installed a Liftmaster Jackshaft garage door opener which eliminates the overhead opener. Any overhead door company can assist with a high lift kit and the opener.
