Hi everyone. If you are thinking about driving in the Milwaukee region's DE on July 23 at Road America, sign up now. There are only a few spots remaining in each group (5 in Novice, 22 in Intermediate and 24 in advanced). As the event approaches, there are numerous activities and things to prepare for. For example:

If you are a Novice Driver

If you are new to the DE experience, we invite you to attend a Zoom meeting on June 12 at 11 a.m. During this call, we are going to have our safety officer do a presentation about the day, including discussion of terminology, what you will learn on and off the track, what to bring and a comprehensive review of the day (it's action packed). We will also have one of our tech experts discuss the significance of this checklist and how to get it completed. If you can attend this meeting, please email us at DE@porschepark.org and we will send you the invitation to connect.

Intermediate and Advanced Drivers

We limit our group sizes to 50 cars, which means you will have a lot of room to work on your HP driving skills. If you are eligible to be an instructor, you will also get an extra 30-minute session added to your day. Be sure to sign up ASAP as the early registration discount will end shortly.

FAQ

As always, we plan for a great weather day, but just in case here are the answers to some FAQs:

1. What happens if it rains? We drive, unless weather conditions are extreme.
2. Do I have to drive a Porsche? This is a great question...No, but depending on what you are bringing, you might want to reconsider.
3. Can I bring a crew? Yes, up to three people?
4. Can I bring my child? You can, but you also need the appropriate waiver signed and follow the age requirements on that form.
5. What is my car number? When you registered, you selected _____ your car number. Review the Motorsportreg.com site to confirm, if needed.
6. What forms do I need to bring with me? All drivers need to bring the Emergency Contact form and completed tech form (and signed tech form). See below.
7. What type of helmet do I need to use? You MUST use a SA SNELL rated helmet, 2010 or newer. If you bring any other type of helmet, you cannot drive or will have to rent a helmet (rentals are limited). Please check as we cannot allow DOT or M rated helmets to be used in PCA DE events.
