and requested the Milwaukee region transfer eight counties from their region to the new region. The eight counties were Brown, Calumet, Door, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Marinette, Waupaca and Winnebago. Ococnto county was added just prior to the approval to make the original boundary contiguous.





Porsche is introducing the 911 Spirit 70, the third 911 in a series of limited production Heritage Design models that pay tribute to the past. The latest model celebrates the 1970s and early 1980s. A total of 1,500 examples will be offered globally, following in the footsteps of the 911 Targa 4S <u>Heritage</u> Design Edition and the 911 Sport Classic. The 911 Spirit 70 takes advantage of the latest high-performance powertrain and chassis technology from <u>Porsche</u> by using the <u>911 Carrera GTS</u> Cabriolet with rear-wheel drive as its basis. Thus, it shares the same standard equipment as the new 911 GTS models, including the high-voltage system, eTurbo, electric motor, and 3.6-liter flat-six engine developing a total system output of 532 hp and 449 lb.-ft. of torque.



# Porsche reports record U.S. retail sales for first quarter 2025

**Atlanta.** Porsche Cars North America, Inc. (PCNA) today announced that first-quarter retail deliveries in the United States totaled 18,884 vehicles, up 40.6 percent from the first quarter of 2024 and up 8.1 percent, from the previous first-quarter record set in 2023. Demand is robust across most model lines and deliveries increased significantly after the supply-constrained first quarter of 2024.
